Learning and Teaching

Your child deserves the highest possible standard of learning and teaching.

John Wesley CEM Primary School will:

- Provide a balanced connected curriculum which challenges, engages and inspires children as well as enabling them to become independent and resilient learners
- Share with parents regularly what their child is learning and how they are progressing

In return we ask that parents:

- Take an interest in their child's learning and support them whole heartedly
- Read daily with their child
- Praise their child's learning and attitudes
- Ensure equipment that is required, such as P.E kit and book bag, is always in school

We ask that children:

- Come into school ready to learn
- Respect other children's right to learn
- Complete their learning to their best ability

Communication

We believe that effective communication between home and school is essential to ensure that your child receives the support needed.

John Wesley CEM Primary School will:

- Ensure parents receives information about their child's learning, progress and behaviour
- Engage in regular means of contact to discuss progress and future targets
- Listen and respond to any concerns raised by parents
- Be available to speak to parents

In return we ask that parents:

- Contact school at the earliest opportunity to discuss anything which might affect their child's learning, behaviour or attendance
- Attend parents' evenings and meetings to discuss their child's learning and progress
- Raise any concerns directly, and promptly, with the school
- Inform school promptly about any changes in circumstances such as phone numbers, addresses or medication
- Return letters and consent slips promptly and by the deadlines specified

We ask that children will:

- Hand all written communication to their parents
- Share any worries or concerns with staff as they arise so that they can be resolved immediately

Attendance

Children have the right to an education and parents have the legal responsibility to make sure that their child attends regularly.

John Wesley CEM Primary School will:

- Contact parents as soon as possible if their child is absent without an explanation, from school
- Will always be aware of children looking unwell and will contact parents to collect them to take home if required
- Recognise and reward good attendance

In return we ask that parents:

- Ensure their child attends school every day and on time unless they are ill
- Inform the school as early as possible if they know that their child will not be at school and keep us informed about any ongoing illness.
- Arrange all holidays or absences from school outside school term times
- Book medical appointments after school or in the holidays, where possible

We ask children to:

- Attend school every day, on time, dressed correctly and be ready to learn

Behaviour

Children learn best in an environment where high standards of behaviour are present.

John Wesley CEM Primary School will:

- Consistently apply the Behaviour Policy to ensure safe and effective learning environments are present at all times
- Ensure that staff, parents, visitors and children understand the Behaviour Policy
- Liaise with parents ASAP following any incidents involving their child

In return we ask that parents:

- Praise and celebrate their child's good behaviour and attitude to learning
- Support the school's Behaviour Policy
- Work with the school to challenge and modify any unacceptable behaviour
